

### **ABOUT GUSFF**

Global University Students Film Festival (GUSFF), with its dedication to encourage and recognize university student films on an international level, connects the global film community and its audiences with outstanding works and groundbreaking ideas.

### **OUR JOURNEY**

GUSFF is formerly known as the Global Chinese Universities Student Film and Television Festival (GCU), which was initiated by the Academy of Film, School of Communication of Hong Kong Baptist University in 2002.

GCU is considered as a flagship event of its kind and is positioned as one of the most successful gateways in building a collaborative relationship among the professionals, scholars and students in Hong Kong and those in the Greater China region.

- Since 2002, GCU has steadily gained recognition from tertiary institutions from home and abroad. Last year, 56 institutions in Australia, Bulgaria, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Mainland China, Malaysia, Russia, South Korea, Taiwan, the UK and the US participated to compete for 17 awards;
- In 2016, GCU introduced the Foreign Category to its short film competition in view of the Festival's growing popularity among the overseas film schools, and foreign entries were invited to compete for three Foreign Awards;
- Over the years, the Festival's star-stunned award ceremonies have been broadcasted by major Hong Kong television stations, including TVB, ATV, RTHK and ViuTV, and online platforms.

To ride on its success, this year, GCU refreshes its brand and the GUSFF is launched with a global focus as a continuation and expansion of the successful initiative to support university student film projects.

### MISSION

GUSFF strives to encourage and recognize emerging filmmakers among university students, foster creative exchange among film students around the world, and enable synergy between regional young talents and international creative industry. To achieve the mission, GUSFF offers an opportunity, and a platform, for showcasing talent, exchanging ideas and fostering network.

### PROGRAMME

### Short Film Competition and Award Presentation Ceremony

The Festival will showcase student films from around the globe to display a panoramic view of the inner world of the young filmmakers. It gives the aspiring filmmakers a sound board for them to be heard and motivated to further explore their potential.

The short film competition is open to international university students, and invites submissions of four categories: Drama, Documentary, Animation and Experimental. All entries will be subjected to a competitive selection process. The jury comprises world-class industry practitioners at home and abroad, including Oscar and Emmy award-winning masters.

An Award Presentation Ceremony will take place to celebrate the outstanding productions. Chief award-winning entries will be awarded a cash prize of USD 10,000 for each entry plus trophy.

### Master Class

Renowned filmmakers and artists as well as distinguished scholars and professionals in the creative media sector will be invited to hold master classes and exchange sessions.

### Screenings

To connect the filmmakers with the audience, student film screenings will be organized for open discussions and exchange of ideas. The films selected for the screenings will include shortlisted entries and outstanding student productions of the year.

### Pitching

Participants are welcome, as individual or a group, to submit a 100-word synopsis of a story idea that has yet been put into production. Those who are selected will be given 5 to 10 minutes of pitching time to present the idea. The juries will comment on each pitch and the most outstanding presentations will be awarded.

# TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

Participants are expected to make their own travel arrangement, while subsidy on flights and accommodation may be provided to eligible participants (more details will be released after the submission deadline).

It is the sole responsibility of the Entrant to clear all content of the film from any and all actual or potential legal claims and issues, including but not limited to claims based upon using music, stock footage, and any other elements contained and/or used in the film. The Festival will not be held responsible for any legal issues that might arise from the inclusion of unclear materials in the film.

### F. Use of Materials and Coverages 作品放映、展出及收藏

- 1. For entries which are to be awarded or selected for presentation in the Festival, the Festival has the right to: 若參賽作品得獎或被選為入圍作品·主辦單位有權:
  - use no more than 6 minutes of the entry for promotion purposes in any and all media;
  - 採用整個作品不多於六分鐘作宣傳用途;
  - present the entry in the Festival; and
  - 在電影節中播放及展出該作品;及
  - to arrange local non-commercial presentation on online platform or TV channels for the entry within a year after the award presentation ceremony.

- 2. The Organizer has the final decision on presentation arrangement.

- 3. Unless the Entrant objects in writing, the Organizer has the perpetual right to keep one copy of each entry for educational, archival and research purposes.
